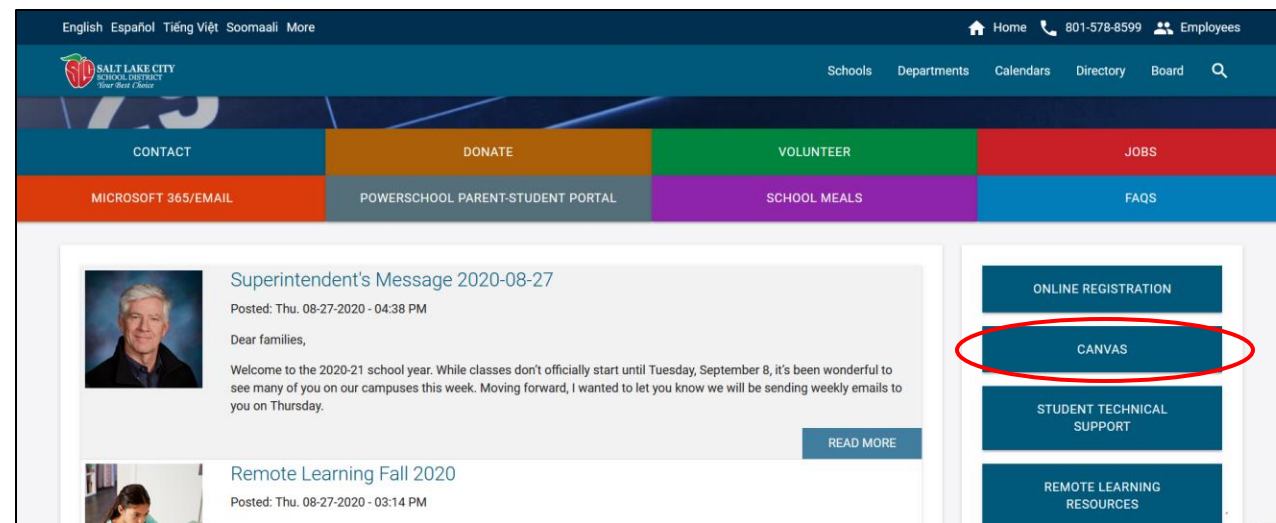

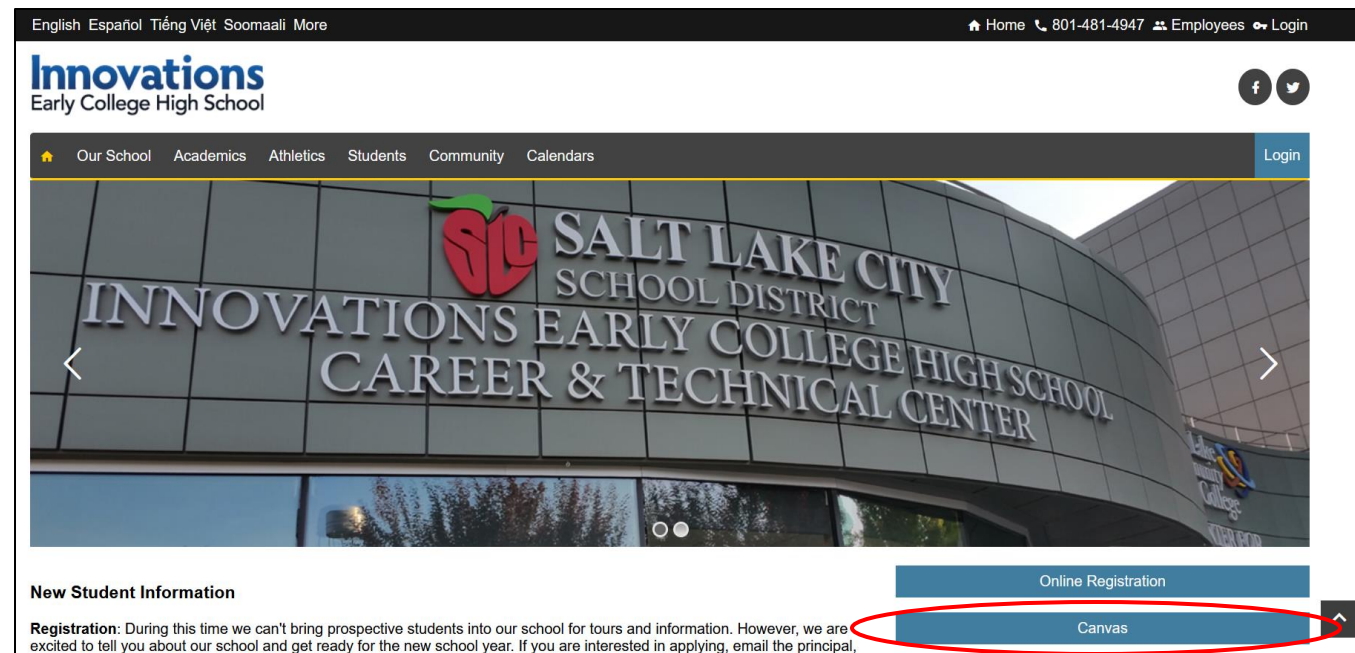
1. There are two ways to access Canvas. The first way is through the SLCS D homepage:

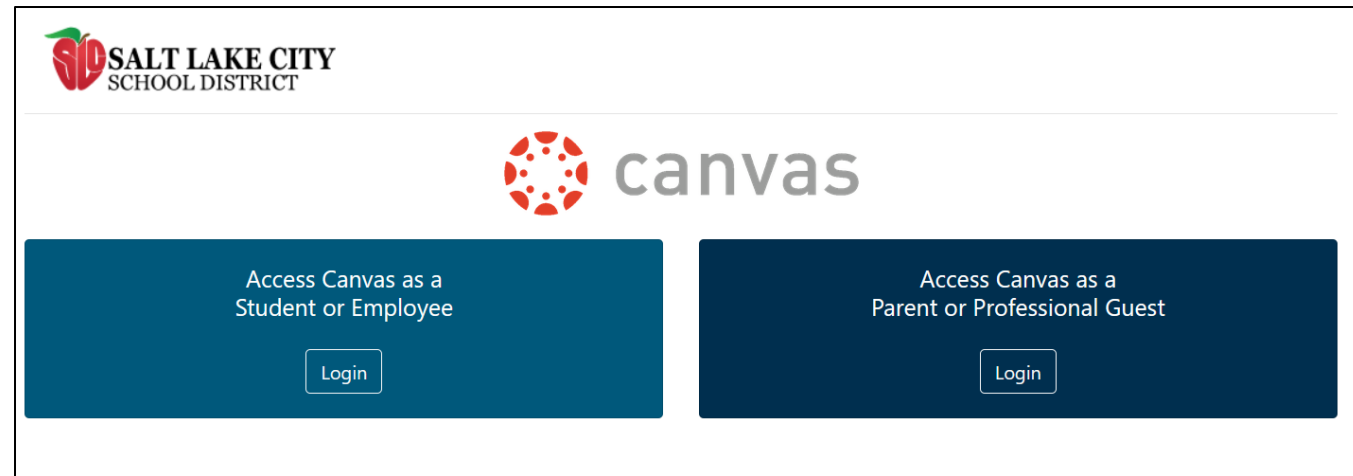



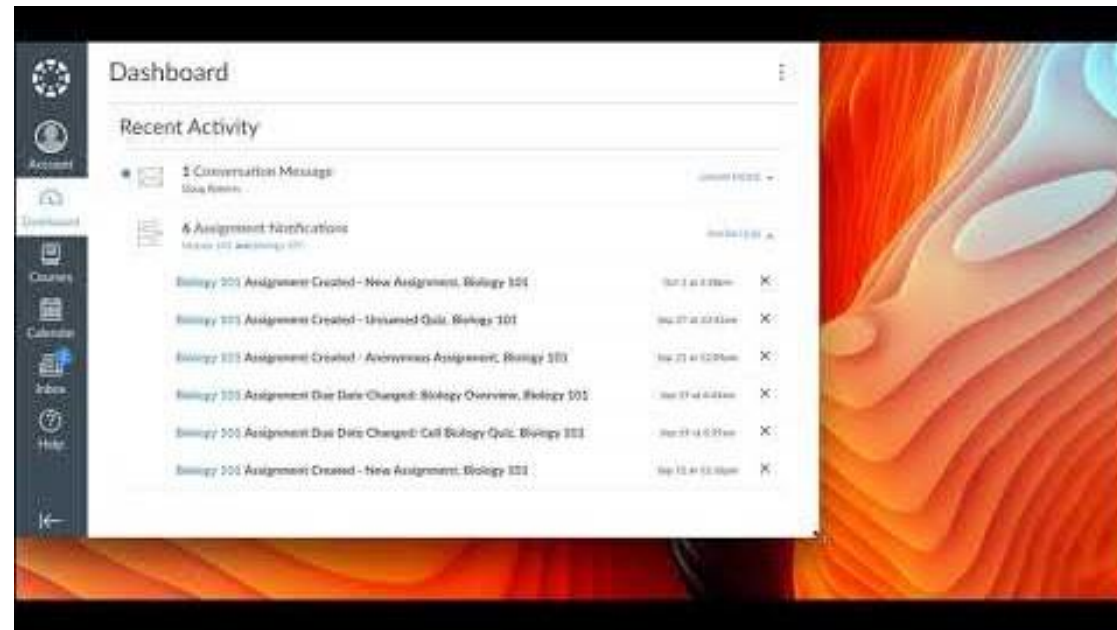
6. Clicking on the “Parent or Professional Guest” access will take you to the following log on screen.




8. If you have not created a parent account, the process is simple. Instead of entering a username and password, click on the “Click Here For An Account.”

9. You need to fill out the following information; instructions on how to get a pairing code are in the following slides:

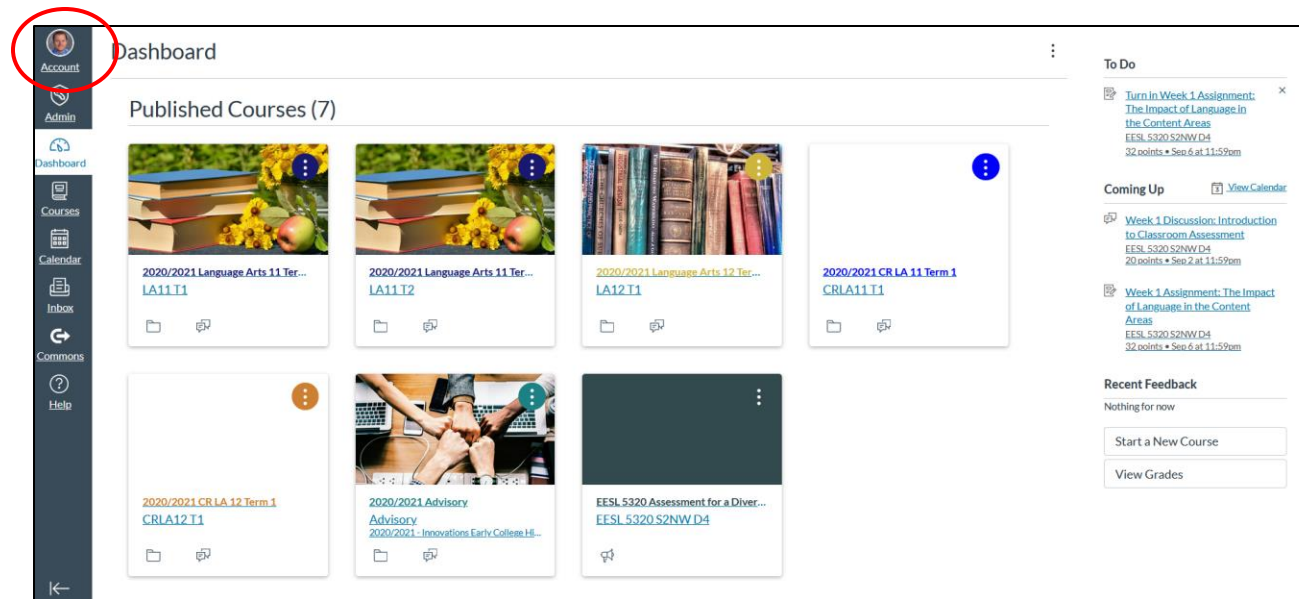


Pairing Code

10. There are two ways to get a pairing code: you can either request one through your student's mentor teacher or you can have your child generate one. To have your child generate a pairing code, go to their Canvas dashboard and click on "Account."


