


## Summer Assignment for English 9 & English 9 Honors (Summer 2021)



## Required Book:

1. *Persepolis* by Marjane Satrapi ISBN-8601419944736

**Directions:**You are to complete <u>both</u> parts of the assignment listed below. Summer assignments are due the first day of school, <u>late work will not be accepted</u>.

- As you read, you will need to create a 10 part comic strip of an event from the story from another character's perspective. Find an interesting character (not Persepolis) to make a comic strip story.
  - a. To start, pick a character that you find interesting and one that experiences major events. Re-do the one event in that new character's perspective.
  - b. Make an outline of 1-10 in your notebook to help you plan the story from the character's perspective.
  - c. When you have the outline and have planned the story Make a 10 box comic strip with 5 boxes on one page and 5 boxes on another page.
  - d. Make sure that each box has <u>dialogue</u> and that each box is in <u>color</u>.
- **2.** When you are almost done reading the graphic novel, write a one and a half page, double spaced essay describing how the events within the novel relate to current events today. Discuss at least 2 or more events from the novel to compare and contrast with current events.
