Required Book: *Persepolis: The Story of a Childhood* by Marjane Satrapi ISBN: 9780375714573

Make Memories in a Scrapbook

Create a <u>digital</u> scrapbook using Google Slides from the main character's point of view that reflects and analyzes significant conflicts and moments. You will need a computer and internet access to complete this assignment. Assignment must be typed in MLA format.

Your scrapbook should include:

- <u>5 Diary Entries</u> written by the main character at critical points within the story where they experienced an internal or external conflict. Entries must be written in the main character's "voice"; they should sound like the kinds of thoughts and worries that they have throughout the novel. You should go beyond what is actually said in the book. Diary entries should be 1 page each. (Label as diary entry #1 and diary entry #2.)
- <u>3 Mementos</u> objects/ keepsakes that symbolize significant moments that the main character experiences. Each memento must be accompanied by a paragraph explanation of its significance. What did they want to remember and why? (Label as memento #1, memento #2, and memento #3).

Grading:

- Assignment must be completed by the first day of school. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Assignment will be submitted on Turnitin.com and Google Classroom the first week of school.
- The use of study guides (SparkNotes, Shmoop, etc.) are not acceptable sources of academic literary
 analysis. Additionally, working from such sites without crediting them is PLAGIARISM. Copying or
 submitting the same work as another student is also plagiarism and is not allowed. Either action, if
 detected, will result in, at minimum, a zero for the assignment. I would rather you get your analysis flat
 wrong all by yourself than steal it from somebody else!
