#### **Part 1: Register for Flinn Prep AP Biology Course**

- **Step 1: Flinn Prep Student Account Creation**
  - Please visit the following website to create a student account for FLINN PREP:

- **Step 2: Purchase Course & Activate Your Key Code**
  - Click “Course Catalog” and select “AP Biology Prep Course (FlinnPREP™ for AP® Biology)” followed by “Purchase Individual Key Code” (\$22.95 + tax)
  - When a course is purchased through the FlinnPREP™ program the user will receive an 8-digit registration key on a confirmation page after the transaction has been approved. This registration key will need to be entered on the “Redeem Keycode” page to activate a course.
- **Step 3: Activate a Student Linking Code**

    - 4. Include DIAGRAMS/FIGURES (Diagrams and figures should be neat, appropriately labeled/described, and appropriately sized - as diagrams that are too small are not useful to study from).
