### Finances update

- District Foundation ready to implement Mobile Beacon grant for 25 laptops and high-speed hot spots – dates have been moved to start the grant until Sept.
- Land Trust Grant Budget approved but we will have time to review next year
- Gear UP Budgets finalized
  - Reviewed what Land Trust and Gear Up budgets pay for which is mostly tutor time and a math teacher and STEM supplies for school. All budgets work together for the good of our students. Parents thought it was good and thought having more time to approve or change the Land Trust grant in the fall was good.

#### How students have been doing through the closure

- Grades submitted before Jan 6 March 13: 1,047 quarter credits complete
- Grades submitted after March 16 to May 11: 889 quarter credits complete!
- Support for students how did it go?
  - All parents present took turns to tell how their student has felt supported.
