SIC Update

- Main focus – review 19-20 School Improvement Plan and starting goals for new SIC plan for this school year. 19-20 Reading/Math I/ Volunteer Work. 20-21 Adding In new Science Curriculum and expanding math to all 3 years of math and working on SEL assemblies HB58. Circles and assemblies and mentoring.
- Committees as staff – Joie was asked if there are any parents willing to help with recruiting. He would love to meet with any parents interested. Work with Pam, Joie. There is still room for enrollment in upper grades, but focus on 8th grade. Email Joie if interested.

Principal Updates

- ACT practice imbedded in every curriculum. At one point they were focusing on composite scores. Despite changes, composite scores have remained around the same 19.1 is OVER what is expected. Over 18 is bar. Since they have been focusing a lot on math, average math score years have been below state average 17.6. Last year our math average was 18.3. Huge!
- Scholarship applications are open for Spring 2021. Set aside \$10K a year to help pay for tuition, textbooks, and supplies. It is a very easy application. They want all Jrs and Srs to be taking this. Mentor teachers and tutors are happy to help fill out the application.
- End of 1st Term. 2nd term starts tomorrow. Moving forward. We don't FAIL. Just keep going.

SLCC Presentation

- College credit and high school credit given at same time.
- Requirements: Jr/Sr to take classes on campus at SLCC, minimum GPA requirements, SLCC application and fee, Signed parent permission form (each year), maybe SLCC placement test scores
- Placement tests are being done remotely.

- College terms: credits (# of hours spent in class/week); full time (12 credit hours); generals are classes that are part of the core curriculum, usually 1st year of 4-year degree; majors are the field of study 30-60 credits; prerequisites a class that you must take prior to taking another class.
- MyCE – high school counselor will have access. Helps to make sure they are on track.
- Students are asked a series of questions to help with planning.
- Choose your path: Associate’s Degree? Couple Classes? Certificate of Completion (Generals)?
- Taught on SLCC Campuses. An increase in online options.
- Taught by SLCC Instructors.
- \$4/Credit Hour
- FERPA - College cannot disclose information about student. Cannot release information without student signing a release. This only applies to the College. Not the High School.
- Students in charge of grades, class selections, keeping up with deadlines for SLCC and high school, and e-mail correspondence.
- Getting ready to meet ideas of course of study, meet with high school counselor, make an appointment with SLCC CE Advisor. Will help with course planning.
- Steps: CE Website, Advising, School’s appointed advisor, Schedule an appointment, choose a time that is best for you.
- Drop Class by deadline – receive full refund and no academic penalty
- Withdrawal will remain on transcript and may impact financial aid. It will count as an attempted credit. Prior to withdrawal they recommend tutoring for classes.
