Summer Work for Transitional Algebra, Algebra 2, and Honors Algebra 2

How to create a Khan Academy Account for summer work to prepare for
Transitional Algebra, Algebra 2 or Honors Algebra 2

1. Add yourself to this Google Classroom: **oswedfv**
2. Go to www.khanacademy.org and **click** on the bar that says “Learners, Start Here.” It is best to do this on a lap top.
3. Click on “Learner”. Enter your birthdate.
4. Click, “Continue with Google.” Enter your school email address and password:

Go to your email and click on the link to finish signing up, if needed.

If it asks you to allow access to your google account, click “Allow.”
5. Your user name will most likely be chosen as your gmail account. Please leave it as is. Don’t use a nickname or funny saying as your user name because we can’t give you credit for your work if we can’t recognize your name.
6. Create a password. Choose an Avatar or modify it later, if you want.
7. Click on your name in the top, right corner. Click “Profile.” Then, click “Teachers”
- 8. Join the class by entering this class code: QPWGX9AC**

(9. You might not have to do this but if so, go to “Math by Subject” and choose Algebra 1.)

You are required to complete up to 6 hours of work on this website for credit in your math next year. You MUST master certain ‘topics’ that have been chosen for you. There will be assignments that you will complete.

Important Notes:

- *You will need paper and pencil for this work. Use a binder or notebook where you have space.
- *You should complete this without a calculator.
- *If you watch videos, they may only count for up to 2 hours of your 6 required hours.
- *You can check your progress (time accumulated) by clicking on your name, profile, progress, activity.
- *It will take you more than 6 hours to accumulate the 6 hour time. The site stops counting when your computer sits idle or you work on something for longer than a short time without doing anything on the computer.
- *You will receive an email from Mrs. Bain when you have completed your 6 hours or mastered your ‘tasks’. Emails are typically sent by Mrs. Bain about once a week over the summer.
