Meeting called to order: 7:30 P.M.

Motion to accept Minutes for the September 10, 2009 regular meeting made by Charlie Bettinger, second by Jon Paul Roden. Unanimously passed.

Agenda Item 2: Request from Cory Craft, 274 Bolton Road, for a second curb cut.

Motion to approve made by Jon Paul Roden, Second by Charlie Bettinger. Unanimously passed.

Agenda Item 3: Request for “No Parking Zone” on Church Street near Rails to Trails..

Presentation made by Paul Maregelony on behalf of residents on Church Street.

Discussion: Issue is overflow parking from Rails to Trails parking lot blocking mailboxes for residences and having to walk between cars is hazardous while crossing street.

Chief Kenny reported that the Vernon Post Master was contacted and agreed to allow the moving of mailboxes to the south side (residence side) of the street effective 10/24/09.

Motion made to post south side (residence side) of Church Street as no parking, made by Chief Kenny, second by Lucas Watson. Unanimously passed.

Agenda Item 4: Instillation of signage on Bamforth Road in the area of #265

Discussion: Chief Kenny indicated that a new residence currently under construction at #265 has a issue with a limited sight line for the new driveway regarding south bound traffic on Bamforth Road. Chief Kenny recommended instillation of a “Curve Ahead” sign prior to the curve in the 200 block and a “Hidden Driveway Ahead” be installed prior to the driveway on Bamforth Road.

Motion made to accept recommendations of Chief Kenny for sign instillation made by Lucas Watson, second by Charlie Bettinger. Unanimously passed.

Agenda Item 5: Presentation of concerns from Skinner Road school area.

Presentation to Authority was made by Charles Chatterton regarding sign improvements to crosswalks in the school zone. Mr. Chatterton indicated that they would like Yield to Pedestrian in cross walk signage be installed to the support poles currently at the crosswalk. PTO would supply the signs.

It was decided that the signage would be installed on the traveled side of the road only.

Motion made to install the PTO signs by Vernon DPW made by Charlie Bettinger, second by Jon Paul Roden. Unanimously passed.
