- The student will write down the titles of the non-chapter books he/she reads over the summer on the reading log. **The student must write a complete sentence** answering **one** of the prompts below for each non-chapter book he/she reads. The student will record the title, number of pages, number of points, and a complete sentence for each non-chapter book they read on the reading log.
- If your child chooses **to read chapter books**, he/she will be required to **write a 3-4 sentence summary** for the written response in the space provided on the reading log. The students will earn **one point for every 20 pages** they read. Each chapter book **must have the designated summary**.

The log must be completely filled out and the **total number of points** written at the bottom of this page. Students who earn at least **30 points** will be invited to a **special celebration** in the fall. Your child's log should be turned in to his/her Language Arts teacher no later than Friday, August 20th, 2021. We wish you a happy summer full of great stories! ☺

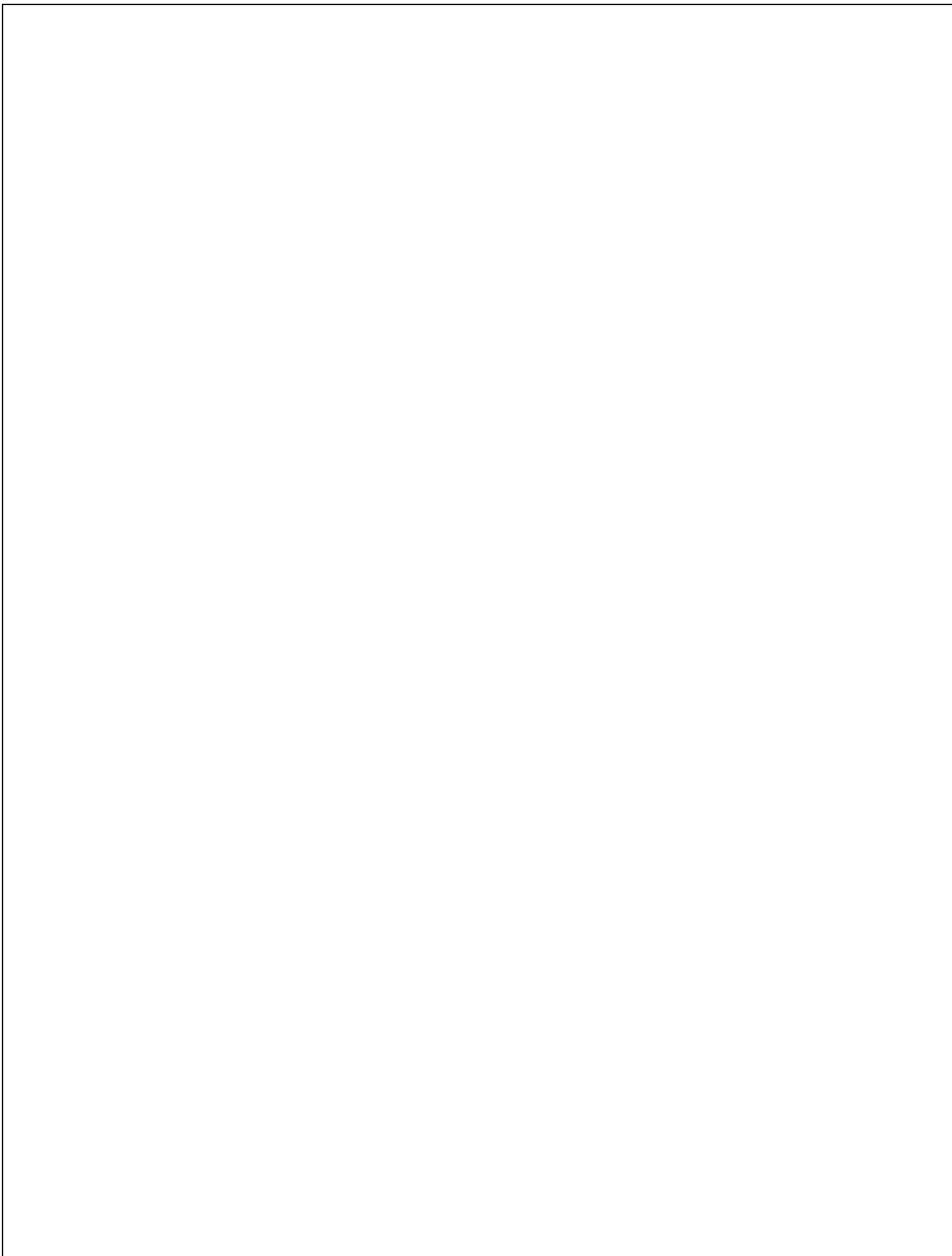
