A review of KISD Policies/Procedures/Protocols to maximize student and staff health & safety as related to Covid-19 was presented by Stephanie Reeves, RN. KISD has implemented Covid-19 vaccinations for employees, Covid-19 Testing program for staff and students, and Covid-19 protocols to keep students and staff healthy. This has involved many hours of Covid-19 contract tracing by multiple staff and KaufmanISD will continue to monitor for Covid and test for Covid throughout the district.

Please see attached KISD Mother-Friendly Workplace proposal with TDHS partnership. A pilot program area has been established at KHS with the assistance of Roslene Pruitt,RN and Susan Atkinson. This program is designed to support Mother and Baby @ KISD. We also recently received a Grant with TDHS for purchase of equipment-breastfeeding pump and stand with the help of Patricia Rivera-Texas Department of Health program representative.

KISD is proud to rollout Hazel Telehealth Services for KISD students and the success of our consent campaign that is well underway. Roberto Drouet presented to the SHAC a Hazel Health presentation and the great success of the program thus far. Hazel Health helps with urgent care issues, immediate medical support for KISD Nurses to provide efficient care for student physical and mental needs, and helps support positive continuity of care for students and families. This is currently a free program to parents and provides many resources to families of KISD.

Employee Wellness was discussed by Stephanie Reeves, RN for this 2020-2021 school year. KISD has provided an employee flu shot clinic, Covid-19 Vaccination employee shot clinic in partnership with Kaufman County Emergency Management, and employee Mobile Mammogram Screenings. KISD continues to offer services thru our Fitness program and Fitness Center.

Walk Across Texas Physical fitness program and physical activities to address healthy habits for students and families at KISD was presented by speaker Katie Sotzing with the Texas A&M Agricultural Extension office. This year 447 Monday Elementary School students participated in the youth version and walked 4409 miles with the assistance of Melanie Negri, PE teacher.
