BHRS– “Wrap around” Supports

BHRS (Behavioral Health Rehabilitation Services) are a group of services that can be offered through medical assistance. These services are offered in the child’s natural setting- your home, the school, the community. “Individuals who have medical assistance (MA) are eligible to receive medically necessary BHRS services until the day before their 21st birthday” (from <http://www.dpw.state.pa.us/>).

These services include Behavioral specialist Consultant (BSC), Therapeutic Staff Support (TSS) and Mobile Therapy (MT).
