



Harbin Named New Milam Principal

TUPELO, Miss. — Terry Harbin is returning to the Tupelo Public School District.

Monday in a special called Board of Trustees meeting, Harbin was approved as the new Milam principal. He replaces Paul Moton, who is now the district's new Director of Educational Enhancement and Innovative Design.

In addition to teaching fifth-grade math at Milam and serving as an assistant principal at New Albany Elementary, Harbin was Lawndale's principal from 2006-12. He was also an adjunct professor at Ole Miss from 2010-2016 and was the Administration & Supervision Program Coordinator at Delta State from 2012-15.

In 2008, he became the fourth TPSD principal to be named Mississippi's Administrator of the Year.

Harbin, a 1980 graduate of Tupelo High School, returns to his home district after spending the past four years as principal at Itawamba Attendance Center, where he guided the school to an "A" rating.

He and his wife, Angela, have been married since 1987. They have two children, Peyton and Sidney, both THS grads.

"I'm very excited to be returning home to my blue and gold roots," he said.
