Activities should be handwritten/hand-drawn, and you are not allowed to consult any resources beyond the book and your own brain. Be prepared to submit your work on the first full day of class.

If the book had a sequel, what do you think would happen? Write a paragraph telling what should happen next.	Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why or why not? What would you say about this book? Write a book review/recommendation in a well-written paragraph.
What is the main conflict or problem in the story? Answer in a well-written paragraph.	Everyone start HERE! List 5 major events in the book in the order that they happened.	Who are the protagonists in the story? The antagonists? Answer in a well-written paragraph.
Draw a picture of three of the characters in the book. Be sure to include details you found in the text.	Make a map showing at least three locations in the book. Be sure to include details from the text.	List at least three sensory details from the book. Look for passages when a character saw, tasted, smelled, heard, or felt something specific. Copy the sentence, and cite the page number for each image.
