You are to complete this assignment just like a Tic-tac-toe board. **You must complete at least three activities.** Start with the middle square, then choose two more activities. You can go horizontal, vertical, diagonal, or even blackout the whole board if you want! Activities should be handwritten/hand-drawn, and you are not allowed to consult any resources beyond the book and your own brain. Be prepared to submit your work on the first full day of class.

Be sure to include details from the text.</p>	<p>List at least three sensory details from the book. Look for passages when a character saw, tasted, smelled, heard, or felt something specific. Copy the sentence, and cite the page number for each image.</p>
