New Items:

D205 & IDPH Partner to Host a Community-Wide Vaccine Clinic at York - May 22

District 205 is excited to announce a partnership with the Illinois Department of Public Health to host a vaccine clinic for families. Here are the details:

- Location: York Community High School, 355 W. St. Charles Road
Elmhurst, IL 60126-3697
- First Dose: Saturday, May 22, 2021 (Register at this link: <http://bit.ly/Vaccines4Us>)
- Second Dose: Saturday, June 12, 2021 (Register at this link: <http://bit.ly/Vaccines4Us2>)
- Appointments are available between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

While families or individuals can walk in and be vaccinated, we strongly encourage attendees to register in advance so that the process can flow as smoothly and efficiently as possible.

This initiative is designed to help ensure equity in vaccine distribution to groups that have experienced challenges accessing vaccines such as underserved racial/ethnic minorities, rural populations, immigrant communities, and any other community where the clinic could help overcome barriers to vaccination such as language, disability, technology, or transportation.

You must be over the age of 12 to take part in this vaccination event. However, being a student of D205 or York High School is not required.

City of Elmhurst Water Main Project Underway. Delays Expected - Effective Immediately

Contractors for the City of Elmhurst are installing a new water main at West Avenue and working towards Berkley Avenue (south of Elm Park). A small pressure test was conducted today, but the project will officially start on Monday, May 17, 2021.

However, the City of Elmhurst has stated that it will not start work east of Berkley Avenue (south of Elm Park) before May 24. After May 24, work will continue to the east. Plans are to complete all work, including pavement restoration and striping, by August 6, in advance of the opening of the 2021-22 school year.

Traffic and bus delays are expected and will primarily impact York High School and middle school routes at dismissal times. Other routes that may be specifically impacted are:

- Conrad Fischer Elementary - Bus 7
- Madison Early Childhood Education Center - Flamingo Bus
- Sandburg Middle School Buses 1 (Yellow) and 6 (Green)

Parents will be notified as delays occur. Thank you in advance for your patience.
