SENECA FALLS CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT PROFILE



The School District serves children in the township of Seneca Falls as well as parts of Tyre and Fayette. Seneca Falls remained an industrial village well into the 20th century as the home of Goulds Pumps, Sylvania, and Seneca Machine. In recent years tourism has become the major industry in Seneca Falls. Local attractions such as The Women's Rights National Historical Park (including the site of the first Women's Rights Convention and the Elizabeth Cady Stanton House), the National Women's Hall of Fame, the Seneca Falls Historical Society, the Seneca Museum of Waterways and Industry and the Seneca Falls Heritage Area Visitors Center, local wineries, the Finger Lakes, and the beautiful scenery of Central New York all attract visitors to the town of Seneca Falls. The town has also received attention as the likely inspiration for the fictional village of Bedford Falls in Frank Capra's holiday classic movie "It's A Wonderful Life."

SFCSD Strategic Plan, developed by the SFCSD District Steering Committee (Shared Decision Making Team), focuses on Academic Programming, School/Community Connections, and Graduation Rate.

Currently the Town of Seneca Falls is comprised of 9,347 residents with an almost equal percentage of men and women. Seneca Falls has warm summers with an average July temperature of 60-81 degrees Fahrenheit and brisk winters with an average January temperature of 14-32 degrees Fahrenheit. There is a normal annual snowfall of 60 inches.

The Seneca Falls CSD has a wide-variety of athletics programs associated with Section V of the NYSPHSAA. Athletic opportunities begin with Modified (Grades 7-8), Junior Varsity (Grades 9 -10) and Varsity (Grades 11-12). Programs offered: Soccer, Football, Volleyball, Cross Country, Wrestling, Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Lacrosse, Track & Field, Indoor Track, and Tennis

District Technology

The district is quite proud of its progress with Information Technology. All district classrooms are equipped with SMART Board technology. The District utilizes the Google Suite for Education and students are provided a chromebook device (1:1 Districtwide). The entire district also has wireless capability. A District Technology Plan identifies Professional Development, Curriculum & Instruction, Planning/Communication/Evaluation, Attitudes, Resources (Human & Technical), and Funding as its goals. Students are provided with interactive instruction at all grade levels.



The Seneca Falls Central School District has been recognized for excellence. Mynderse Academy's graduation rate is always among the highest in the region. Elizabeth Cady Stanton Elementary School has also been recognized as a "New York State High Achieving Elementary School" and has received a United States Education Department Blue Ribbon Award. Seneca Falls Middle School has been recognized as a "New York State School Committed to Character" by the Academy of Character Education. Frank Knight Elementary School won the Exquisite Corpse Writing Challenge (and received an award winning children's author). The district is very proud of its accomplishments.

A strong Performing Arts Department and Athletic Department also provide many co-curricular and extra-curricular opportunities for students.
