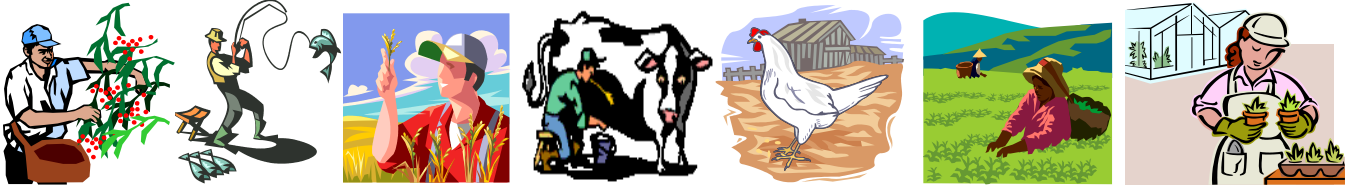
### PARENT SURVEY
