- We are excited to allow each senior to invite two guests. The senior is responsible for providing the name and contact phone # for each attendee to their program instructor by June 7<sup>th</sup>. The guests must give their names to gain entry to the event. No additional guests will be able to attend.
- Parking will be provided on the west end of the WTCC campus. Staff will be posted to assist you.
- Students are expected on campus before and after the ceremony as per the regular daily schedule.
