1. Welcome 9:00

Dr. Malouf welcomed and thanked everyone for attending our SCC meeting. She explained that this is our monthly meeting with families and celebrating students of the month.

2. Approval of Minutes from April SCC 9:05

We will start by reviewing our minutes from the previous meeting which was emailed to SCC members. Minutes were approved.

3. Principal's Report

a. Students of the Month – Growth Mindset 9:05

Dr. Malouf congratulated the students for demonstrating and having a growth mindset which was the monthly theme for May. A slideshow was shown celebrating the students made by Keri Taddie. The counselor, Ms. Hart, discussed how a student showing growth mindset has a positive attitude toward learning, is willing to help, and approaches hard things. The students will receive a certificate and a book. Dr. Malouf will email the video to teachers to show to classes and post it to the school's social media platforms.

b. End of Year Activities

This information will be going out to our families in an email on Monday. For our families who are at home, those who feel safe can and are very welcome to return for our end of year activities. We will be collecting devices and hotspots, starting on Friday, May 28<sup>th</sup>. We will continue to follow all safety measures, wear masks, and hand sanitizer. We want our school year to end in a fun way for everyone. Dr. Malouf discussed the spirit week activities and daily themes. This also includes the last day of school, Monday June 7<sup>th</sup>, which is an early dismissal day at 12:55.

c. Updates for Next Year

Next year MVES will have 5 equalized days (Monday through Friday) with school starting at 8:00 am and dismissing at 2:30 pm, similar to previous years. We worked closely with Glendale to have a similar schedule but it may be adjusted by 10 minutes due to traffic for drop-off/pick up. We will update once the busses and district have finalized those plans. There will be 6 short day/early release days next year.

Dr. Malouf provided an update on the bus situation and explained a parent survey went out.

4. Principal Search Process Update 9:35 Assistant Principal Wowczuk and Keri Taddie

Survey sent to invite feedback from stakeholders. Interview committee made up of representation from the SLCS district, MVES teachers, MVEs staff, CLC, and parents. Interview team will interview selected candidates and make a recommendation to the superintendent who will make the final recommendation.

Question? Were parents already selected and how were they selected?

SCC Chair and teachers made recommendations in which the network coordinator selected the final parents.

Recommendation to have an administrator who brings diversity and represents our students. Important for them to see themselves in these roles.

Dr. Malouf stated this is important and we can only select a candidate from the pool. However, she is not able to be apart of the process but did thank the parent for this item and stated it is valuable feedback.

Nichole Swink stated she is open to parents coming to talk to her and diversity is a very important item for her.

5. Other 9:50

Dr. Malouf thanked the families for her five years and stated there is only one job she would have left Mountain View for. She will stay connected with the community. We have two more weeks together. Truly thank you and I will never be the same.

Keri talked about next Friday, 5/28. We will have one in-person parent meeting. 9-10:30 in the garden, there will be coffee and treats.
