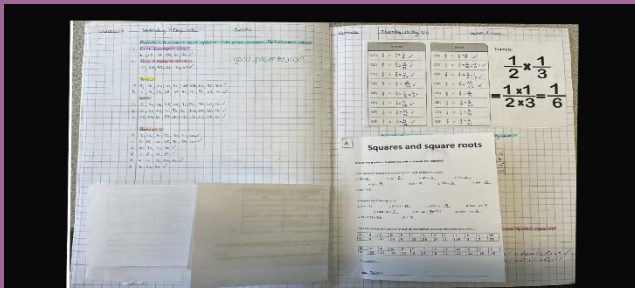

## HEAD TEACHERS BLOG

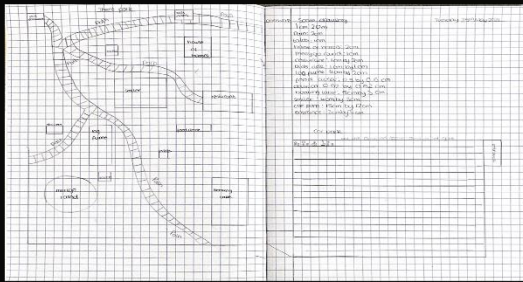

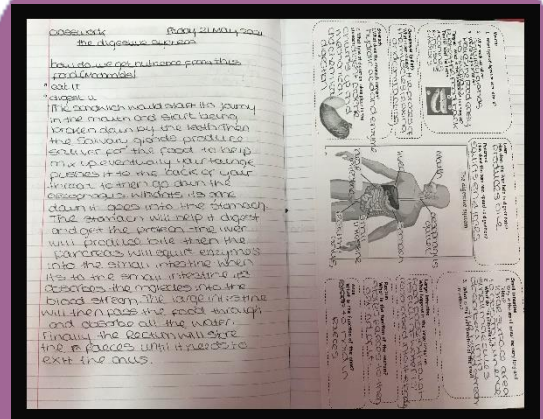
