## DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

Following recommended medical and social distancing protocols, only students, faculty and staff will be permitted on Campus. Drop-Off and Pick-Up will be thru the Franklin House driveway on East French Place (near Main Ave). For students registered for Kids Place, the Drop-Off will begin at 7:30AM when the gate opens. (NOTE: The driveway will likely become heavily trafficked after 8:30AM, with parents waiting to Drop Off for class at 8:45AM. We strongly recommend that Kids Place students be dropped off prior to 8:30AM in order to avoid inconvenience.) Cars transporting students registered for an AM class may enter the driveway from 8:30-8:45AM, but students may not leave the vehicle until staff begins opening car doors at 8:45AM. If registered for an AM class only, the Pick-Up time is 11:30AM. A \$15 fee/quarter hour/child will be assessed after 12:00AM. Students registered for a PM class only may enter the driveway prior to 12:15PM but may not leave the vehicle until 12:15PM when staff begins the class Drop-Off procedure. Afternoon classes end at 3PM. A \$15 fee/quarter hour/child will be assessed after 3:30PM. Kids Place Pick-Up closes at 6pm. A \$15 fee/quarter hour/child will be assessed after 6:00pm.

On the first day of each week, Family Name Cards will be provided. You are requested to place these Name Cards on the passenger side of your dashboard each day to assist our staff in securing your child(ren) from their class and helping them into your car in a timely manner.

Your assistance and patience will be greatly appreciated as, we too, monitor and tweak the Drop-Off and Pick-Up procedures to keep your waiting time as short as possible.

## CDC/MEDICAL/HEALTH INFORMATION

All students, faculty and staff will wear masks and observe social distancing. Temperatures will be taken daily. Frequent hand washing/cleansing protocols will be followed. Free-standing hand sanitizer containers are available throughout the Campus.

If your child will need any type of medication administered during the day, please furnish a doctor's release/prescription along with a note from the parent/guardian. Our Nurse or the Kids' Place Director will handle all medication for students in Kids' Place or Noon Care.

SAA/SATA are proactive in sending ill children home pending medical clearance, and we likewise expect that parents will keep ill children at home until they have been cleared by medical personnel to return to classes.
