

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Number of Members and Terms of Office

The Board of Directors of the Kennewick School District shall consist of five (5) members elected by ballot by the registered voters of the District.

Except as otherwise provided by law, members of the Board of Directors shall hold office for terms of four (4) years and until their successors are elected and qualified. Terms of office shall be staggered as provided by law, and insofar as possible not more than a majority of one (1) shall be elected to full terms at any regular election. In case a member, or members, of the Board of Directors are to be elected to fill an unexpired term, the ballot shall specify the term for which each such member is to be elected.

Newly elected Directors shall take office immediately after taking the Oath of Office, which shall be administered at the beginning of the first regular meeting after the new Directors are certified.
