REQUIRED Summer Math for Rising 1st-3rd Graders

As the school year comes to a close, it's important for your child to continue learning throughout the summer months. Research shows that a majority of school-aged children experience a "summer slide", losing approximately 2 months of math skills over the break. - Your child should not shy away from incorrect answers, as they help find the right lesson to build learning progress.
- We know it's difficult, but please **resist the urge** to help with answers so that your child doesn't move ahead before he or she is truly ready.

(Students should begin with the DreamBox Math Green app first, before moving on to the DreamBox Math Blue.)
