


1993 MYNDERSE VOLLEYBALL TEAM

The 1993 Girls' Varsity Volleyball team was comprised of a great group of young ladies. We had little experience, with 8 juniors without varsity experience. At the start of this season, Mynderse entered the Fingerlakes West league for the first time. This was due to school size and lack of sectional experience. We finished the new league in second place with a 7-3 league record and a 15-8 overall record.
