

INSTRUCTIONAcademic Freedom

Education may be fostered and promoted in an atmosphere in which academic freedom for staff is encouraged and promoted, with due consideration to the rights of the students and community. Teachers are entitled to academic freedom subject to accepted standards of professional responsibility. These responsibilities are defined as commitment to democratic tradition; a concern for the rights, welfare, growth and development of children; objective scholarship; recognition of the maturity level of students; and the district curriculum.
