DRESS EXPECTATIONS

- Best dress is expected.
- Your clothes will be checked as you line up.
- Nothing disruptive.
- NO jeans, NO tennis shoes, NO flip-flops, NO shorts, NO tank tops, NO halter tops, NO formal dresses
- Wear either slacks, a skirt, or a dress.
- Be careful to wear sensible shoes as you will be standing and walking.
- Hang your gown up as soon as you get home. DO NOT IRON YOUR GOWN!
- Wear the SHS Class of 2021 mask you were just given.

CORDS AND GOWNS

- Honor cords, Pathway cords, Sterling Scholar and National Honor Society stoles are allowed on the outside of your gown.
- Scholarship, academic pins, high honor and honor roll pins, and nationally recognized group awards are also allowed. (Examples: DECA, FBLA, FCCLA, FFA, HOSA, LIA, AND SKILLSUSA).
- If you are uncertain what is allowed, make sure to talk to the administration for approval.
- You should pin anything loose to your gown so they don't slip off.
- NO DECORATIONS are allowed (on your cap, leis, etc.)!!!


LINING UP

- You need to be lined up by 4:00 p.m. (You can start lining up around 3:45 p.m.)

- You will line up alphabetically and numerically by your card number.
- Class officers/SB0s will be at the front of the **EVEN** line.


TASSEL AND INSTRUCTIONS

- Family and friends should also be in best dress.
- Air horns and other distracting noise makers are not allowed.
- Tickets are required for your family and friends. They should have obtained those virtually through Weber State's ticketing system.




Where will I sit??

In the tunnel....


BE QUIET!

- 1. Everything will echo, and it gets noisy fast. Use hushed tones. Listen to the faculty members.
- 2. You will receive your diploma cover in the tunnel before you take a picture.

- With your cap and gown, you received a card that has your name and numerical order on it. Please DO NOT LOSE THIS CARD! It will serve three purposes:
 - 1. Help you get in order outside of the tunnel
 - 2. It will be used by the photographer just before your name is read aloud.
 - 3. It is the name that will be read aloud when you are announced


NAME READING

- You will be handed a diploma cover before your name is said, to have your
 official picture taken with it. When you get to the officer, give them your name
 card and quietly say your name to them so they will pronounce it correctly. Even
 if you know the officer, still tell them your name! You may need to repeat your
 name for them because they will be nervous and they want to get it right!
- We want everyone to have their graduation "moment" so walk directly to the
 people handing out diplomas, give an elbow bump or thumbs up, say thank you,
 and take a seat again per the directions of the faculty. You won't be in the same
 seat!



AFTER THE NAMES HAVE BEEN READ

- Tassel switch
- Alma Mater
- Recessional (exit) out of the tunnel where you came in.



DIPLOMAS

- SAFELY cross the crosswalk into the "diploma zone" that is right across from the tunnel.
- FAMILY IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE "DIPLOMA ZONE."
- The counselors will be there handing out your actual diplomas.



GOWNS

Your gowns are due back to Josten's right after the ceremony ends. Take pictures beforehand!!!
