

THE DIOCESE AT A GLANCE

The Roman Catholic Diocese of Erie, Pennsylvania is composed of the thirteen counties in the northwestern part of the state with a Catholic population of about 195,000. Geographically, the Diocese of Erie is the largest in the state covering 10,167 square miles. Much of the diocese is rural with one large city, Erie, and several medium-sized metropolitan areas. The Erie Catholic School System is located in Erie and Millcreek.

The Diocese of Erie has been led by Bishop Lawrence T. Persico, JCL, since October of 2012. In addition to shepherding the diocese through a comprehensive pastoral plan involving schools, parishes and faith formation, Bishop Persico has made it his priority to be with the people in the diocese whenever possible, visiting parishes, schools, and other organizations for a variety of liturgical and non-liturgical events.

The diocese is served by 104 active diocesan priests, as well as some priests from other dioceses or religious communities, 36 retired diocesan priests, and 74 diocesan permanent deacons. There are approximately 213 women religious living in the diocese. The diocese is educating 5,245 students in elementary, middle, and high schools for the 2020-2021 school year. The diocese's religious education programs involve 6,901 elementary and secondary children and youth, including confirmation students.

THE ERIE CATHOLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM

The Diocese of Erie launched the Erie Catholic School System in July 2017 as part of Building in Truth and Love, the comprehensive plan for diocesan schools. It includes six Preschool through Grade 8 Catholic schools located in the City of Erie and Millcreek, all of which have provided excellent Catholic education to Erie families for decades.

Erie Catholic schools are communities where educators and families nurture and shape children in the Catholic faith. The students grow spiritually and intellectually amid a welcoming culture of respect, inclusiveness and shared values rooted in the teachings of Christ.

Across Erie Catholic's six campuses, educators implement consistent curriculum at or above state standards, with an emphasis on increased expectations and measurable outcomes. The schools customize learning to suit individual student needs, using proven Instructional practices that are student-centered, inquiry-based and hands-on.

No longer operating as independent, parish-based schools but as a unified system, Erie Catholic provides consistent leadership, expertise, resources and accountability that strengthens all schools while enabling each to retain its unique community and traditions.

THE POSITION

The Erie Catholic School System is led by a President who reports to a Board of Directors. The Board is responsible for overseeing the Catholic identity, educational quality, and operational vitality of the system of schools. The Board approves the budget and helps to identify strategies for long-term sustainability and growth.

The President works with a team of system-level administrators including Vice President of Enrollment Management, Director of Finance, Director of Human Resources, and Director of Technology. The Vice President is currently serving as Interim President.

OPPORTUNITIES AND CHALLENGES

The next President will be charged with embolding the vision of the Erie Catholic School System with an identity and charism that will be attractive for those seeking a strong Catholic elementary and middle school experience. The Board retained an outside consultant to provide a system-wide self-assessment and related recommendations to strengthen the schools as a whole. The incoming President will have a roadmap to tackle specific goals such as improving early career teacher retention, creating a compelling experience for middle school students in the system, and developing mechanisms to make the schools more accessible to more families.


DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Leadership

- Articulates and promotes the mission and Catholic identity of the school system
- Works with the Board of Directors and its committees in ongoing assessment and development of the mission of the school system
- Serves as the chief representative of the school system in dealings with the educational, civic, and diocesan communities

Strategy and Planning

- Participates in the cultivation of major donors and solicitation of major gifts for the school system with a goal of generating \$1 million annually
- Develops and leads a comprehensive plan and program to market the school system for image, enrollment, and resources





Collaboration with Stakeholders

- Ensures that students, parents, faculty, staff, alumni/ae, and benefactors are aware of and involved in the faith life of the school system
- Maintains a collaborative relationship with the Board of Directors to ensure effective board functioning and operations
- Provides overall leadership for responsible stewardship and appropriate reporting of school system metrics to the Board of Members, Board of Directors, government agencies, and the school system's constituents

Budgeting and Fiscal Oversight

- Involves the principals and building administrators in the annual budget development process
- Ensures compliance with the Board, school system, government, and diocesan policy concerning financial stewardship
- Acts as the chief steward of the school system's fiscal resources with the goal of projecting reasonable budget forecasts and balanced budgets
