MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING TO TRANSFER TO AN ON-LINE SCHOOL

I understand that the Kennewick School District also offers on-line educational programs to the following students:

- For students attending grades K-12, an on-line program is available through the Mid-Columbia Partnership (MCP) at 222-5036 or www.ksd.org (select the tab “Programs”).
- For students attending grades 9-12, an on-line program is available through Legacy High School On-Line at 222-5850 or www.ksd.org (select the tab “Programs”).

I understand that the Kennewick School District’s on-line education programs offer the following:

- Kennewick School District teachers available Monday through Friday to provide personal assistance for the student.
- Teachers available to help develop a comprehensive Student Learning Plan for the student.
- The opportunity for the student to be involved in all co-curricular (academic) and extra-curricular (athletics, music, etc.) programs within the Kennewick School District.
- The opportunity for the student to be co-enrolled in some traditional school programs as well as an on-line program.

I understand that by choosing to enroll in another school district other than the Kennewick School District, the student is:

- Not eligible to participate in any programs associated with the Kennewick School District as long as the student is enrolled in another district.
- Not eligible for any unique programs (Special Education, Migrant Education, Bi-Lingual Education, state testing, etc.). These programs will be handled by the district to which the student is transferring.
- Not eligible to participate in any co-curricular (academic) and extra-curricular (athletics, music, etc.) activities within the Kennewick School District.
