

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school uniform identifies us as a school and its correct use is important. Wearing school uniform is compulsory. Its proper use creates a positive climate for school life.

- ▶ The school has a different uniform for autumn/winter and spring/summer.
- ▶ Students will not be permitted onto the school premises if not wearing full school uniform.
- ▶ All items must be labelled with the student's name.

Uniform description: (0-1 year olds)

Due to their particular characteristics, students between the ages of 0-1 years old may dress as they wish, the school uniform is not mandatory.

Uniform description: Nursery (1-3 year olds)

- Blue tracksuit and white polo shirt (both SEK models) and white trainers (without laces).
- Spring and summer uniform: SEK model shorts and white polo shirt and white, laceless trainers.

Uniform description: From Preschool (3 years old) to Year 6 of Primary School

Girls' uniform

- Plaid skirt (SEK model)
- Grey trousers
- White blouse
- White polo shirt (SEK model) for the spring and summer months
- Navy blue V-neck jumper (SEK model)
- Blue socks or tights
- Blue or black shoes
- Navy blue or black coat

Boys' uniform

- Grey trousers
- White shirt
- White polo shirt (SEK model) for the spring and summer months
- Navy blue V-neck jumper (SEK model)
- Tie (SEK model)
- Navy blue socks
- Blue or black shoes
- Blue or black belt. In Early Childhood Education (we recommend using an elastic waistband instead of a belt)
- Navy blue or black coat

Uniform: from SS Year 1 to Baccaureate Year 2

Winter uniform (from November to March, inclusive)

- Navy blue or black overcoat. Fleeeces, sweatshirts or denim jackets are not permitted as overcoats
- Navy blue, v-neck jersey with school crest
- Blue or black loafer-type shoes
- White lab coat and safety glasses (mandatory over the entire school year)

Boys:

- Grey trousers (not corduroy or casual)
- White shirt
- Tie (SEK model)
- Blue blazer with the SEK shield on the breast pocket (mandatory from ESO)
- Navy blue or black socks (no ankle socks or short socks)
- Navy blue or black belt (mandatory)

Girls:

- SEK tartan skirt (suitable hem length: 5 cm above the knee)
- Grey trousers
- White blouse
- Knee-length navy blue socks or tights

Summer uniform (September to October and April to June)

- White polo-shirt with school crest
- Navy blue, v-neck jersey with school crest
- Blue or black loafer-type shoes
- White lab coat and safety glasses (mandatory over the entire school year)

Boys:

- Grey trousers
- Navy blue or black belt (mandatory)
- Navy blue or black socks

Girls:

- SEK tartan skirt (suitable hem length: 5 cm above the knee)
- Grey trousers
- Knee-length navy blue socks or tights

Both skirts and trousers should be worn on the waist and not the hips. All items must be labelled with the student's name.

Sports kit**► Preschool (3 to 6 years old)**

- White trainers (without laces, only for students Preschool 3)
- Swimming costume and cap (SEK model)

► Year 1 Primary up to Year 1 Baccalaureate

- Tracksuit (SEK model)
- Shorts (SEK model) and short-sleeve t-shirt (SEK model)
- White trainers (younger students preferably without laces) and socks of the same colour
- Swimming costume and cap (SEK model)

Both the school uniform and sports kit can be purchased at *El Corte Inglés*.

NB: Students in Year 2 Baccalaureate and the Diploma Programme do not require sports kit.

Other uniform considerations**The uniform must be worn on school grounds and on school transport routes.**

The regulations in this regard are reflected in the Internal Regulations. Below we include some examples of behaviour and style that are not in line with our way of life:

- Following, on school grounds, outlandish fashion statements which are inappropriate at school or are considered open provocation: body piercings, facial hair including beards, moustaches or goatees, tattoos, nail polish and/or make up. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
- Boys should not wear their hair excessively long and it should be of an equal length. Shaved heads, patterns, lines, dread locks and dyes are not permitted.
