



Bishop O’Gorman Catholic School Summer Busing

Dear Parent,

Thank you for participating in the Bishop O’Gorman Catholic School Summer Care Program. We are happy to offer Summer Care Busing. Students may be dropped off at the St. Michael School (1610 S. Marian Rd.) playground after 7:00 am. **Please check your child in with the staff member on duty.**

The bus will pick students up from St. Michael Elementary at 7:20 am. If your child has registered for, but will not be riding the bus please call the busing supervisor at 941-9212 by 7:15 am.

The bus will pick students up from Holy Spirit at 4:45 pm and arrive at St. Michael at about 5:05 pm. Supervision will be provided until 5:45 at St. Michael. A late fee will be assessed for any child picked up after 6:00 pm.

In case of bad weather, students will wait for the bus inside St. Michael School, Entrance D.

Busing Expectations:

- Students are expected to respect the property of others.
- Students are to sit in their seat facing forward.
- Students are to keep all parts of their body inside the bus.
- Students are to keep arms, legs and belongings to themselves.
- Students are not to throw any object on the bus.
- Fighting, harassment, intimidation and horseplay are forbidden.
- Bus drivers have the right to assign seats to students.
- Call the busing supervisor at 941-9212 if you are signed up for busing, but will not be riding.



If a student has difficulty following the busing expectations,

- The Summer Care Coordinator or Principal will contact parents.
- If the behavior continues, student will forfeit bus privileges for three (3) consecutive days.
- A third busing behavior incident will result in forfeit of bus privileges for the remainder of the summer.
