

INSTRUCTION

Certificate of Educational Competence (GED)

Those students in the Kennewick School District between the ages of 16 to 21 years of age who have a warranted need for seeking a certificate of educational competence shall make application through the building principal who, upon approving their request, will refer them to an official high school equivalency testing center.

The award of the GED certificate shall not preclude a person (under the age of 21) from applying to return to high school if factors that warranted the original application are changed. A Review Committee will evaluate the application to return and make a recommendation to the building principal.
