- On March 5, 2021, Governor Newsom signed Assembly Bill 86 into Law that provided \$4.6B statewide for Expanded Learning Opportunities (ELO) grants.
- LBUSD is eligible for a \$1.7M ELO grant.
- In order to receive funding, a ELO grant plan must be developed and approved by the Board of Education prior to June 1, 2021.
- The plan must include the following:
 - How stakeholders were involved in the development.
 - How student needs will be assessed.
 - How parents will be informed of ELOs.
 - How we'll provide supplemental instruction and support.
 - How funds will be used in coordination with other federal relief funds.

Extended Learning Grant Plan

Actions & Services

- **Extending Learning Time:** summer intervention & enrichment; after-school academic support
- **Accelerating Learning Progress:** additional teachers for smaller class sizes, additional intervention and paraeducator support
- **Integrated Student Supports:** additional mental health staff and support
- **Accessibility:** at-home devices, wifi, parent help desk support, online learning programs
- **Assessments:** universal academic and social-emotional screeners
- **Training & Team Planning:** mental health training, learning outcomes analysis, curriculum adjustments and planning, vertical articulation
