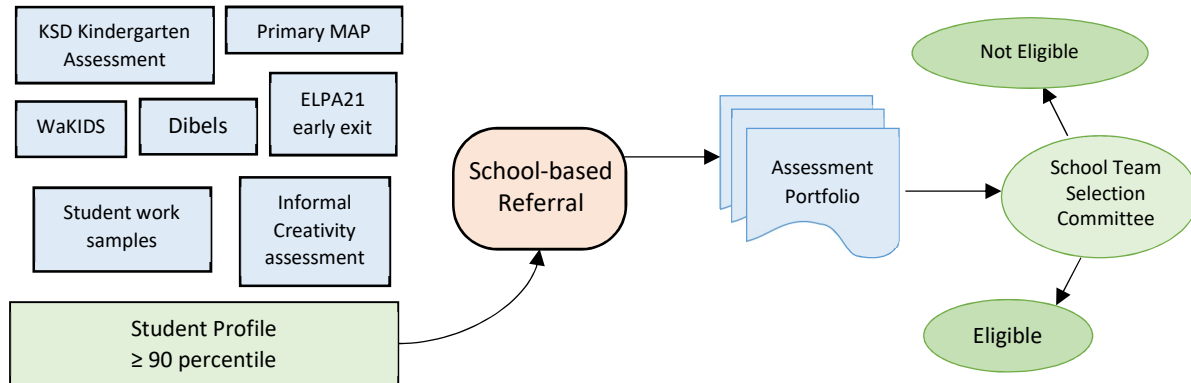


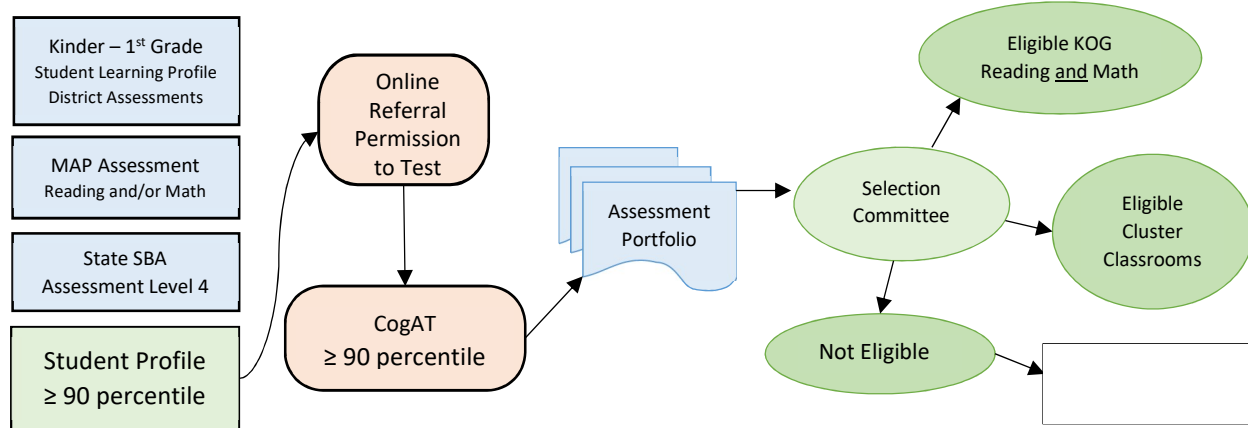
Kennewick School District Highly Capable Programs

Adjustments for local school norms may be considered for qualification

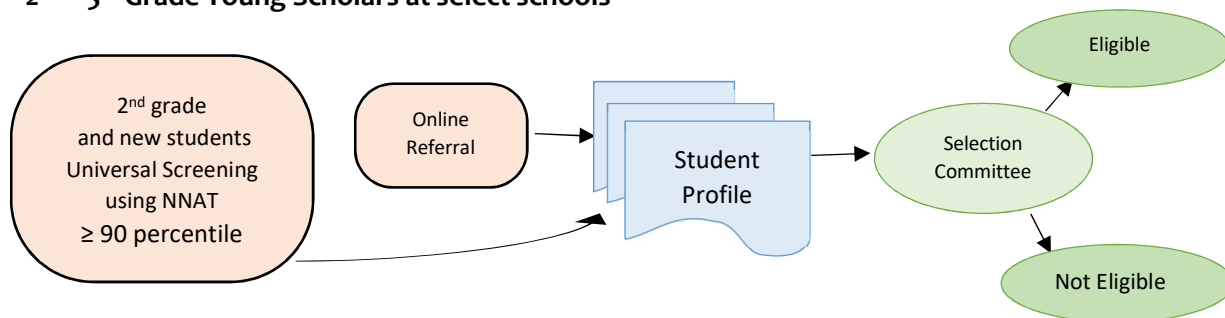
Kindergarten – 1st Grade High Achievers in Reading and/or Math at all schools



2nd – 5th Grade Highly Capable Cluster Model in Reading and/or Math at select schools



2nd – 5th Grade Young Scholars at select schools



7th – 12th Grade Advanced Learning Options at all schools

All students identified as Highly Capable in the elementary school years continue to qualify until graduation. At any time, a parent, guardian or teacher may refer a student who demonstrates characteristics of highly capable learners by contacting a school counselor. The school counselor will work with the district's HiCap director to facilitate the referral. Since students can self-select advanced courses and options in the high school, pursuing identification is not necessary. However, there may be a circumstance in which an underperforming student is assessed to help the student better understand his or her potential and to help reverse underachievement.
