Children can not arrive at school before <u>9:00 AM since there is no supervising until that time</u>. Thank you.

VISITORS

There is currently a temporary restriction on nonessential visitors to school facilities in the district. Prior to entering the building, parents/guardians should contact building administration to arrange a time and to explain the purpose for the visit. Parents and guardians will be allowed to enter the main entrance of the building. For dropping off items such as lunch or items needed during the school day, parents/guardians will be asked to make sure they are labeled and place them on a table in the vestibule. If a parent/guardian needs to drop off medication, please make arrangements with the school nurse ahead of time. To the greatest extent possible, parent meetings will be arranged via conference call or other electronic means.

Visitors with an appointment should report directly to the main office of the school. All visitors are required to scan their drivers license as part of this process. Following the sign-in process a visitor badge is printed and must be worn at all times while on school property. Prior to leaving the school, all visitors <u>must</u> visit the front office and sign-out by scanning their visitor badge.


DROP OFF AND PICK UP PROCEDURES

Arrival Drop Off and Dismissal Pick-up will both operate similarly

- The parent drop-off/ pick-up lane is on the side of the building.
- Parents should enter the school through the main driveway.
- The drop-off/ pick-up lane can accommodate up to four cars at a time.
- Students should exit and enter from the right/passenger side of the vehicle.
- Parents should not get out of the car except to assist their child(ren).
- Students who are dropped off will enter the school building through the cafeteria doors.
- Students who are being picked-up will exit through the cafeteria doors.
- DO NOT pull around a car in the drop-off/ pick-up line, wait for the cars in front of you to pull away.

With patience, courtesy and by following the procedures, all students can be dropped off safely. Allow yourself time so as not to have to rush. Your patience and cooperation are greatly appreciated.

School Dismissal Manager

Region 15 elementary schools all use School Dismissal Manager (SDM). SDM provides an organized and efficient tracking system for afternoon dismissals. In addition, parents can manage their child(ren)'s dismissal quickly and easily using SDM. The system has easy-to-use mobile and desktop interfaces that allow parents to make changes to their child(ren)'s dismissal in advance or for the current day. Parents can report early dismissals and schedule recurring dismissal instructions. Free apps are also available for Android and iPhone users.

Please note that when creating an exception for the current day the cut-off time is 2:10 PM on regular days and 12:00 PM on early release days. If you will need your child earlier than dismissal time, we ask that you schedule an early dismissal pick-up in SDM for at least 30 minutes before the end of the school day; by 12:30 on early release days or 2:40 on a regular days. We understand that there may be a rare family emergency, but with the volume of families providing transportation we will be unable to accommodate last minute pick-ups. If there is an emergency situation you can call the school office. You may call up until 3:00 PM on a regular day, and 12:50 PM on an early release day After that time, the office will be focused on dismissing our students safely and may not be able to respond to your call until after dismissal.

PARENT/TEACHER ORGANIZATION

The PES PTO is very active supporting the school and its mission. Parents and teachers are invited and encouraged to attend all PTO meetings which will be virtual this school year. Mrs. Forish shares the latest information at these meetings. If you cannot make the meetings, the PTO distributes the minutes through the PTO email.
