ROSSVILLE CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT

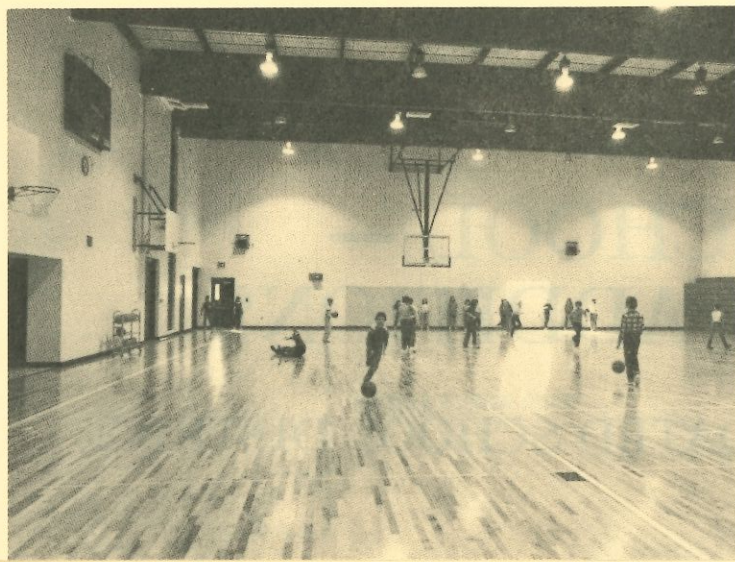


The renovation and additions to the Rossville School, completed during the winter of 1983-84, were the result of many months of planning. The process started with an Educational Planning Study prepared by Dr. Norbet J. Nelson and Dr. Everett W. Nicholson, professors at Purdue University. The Planning Study got underway in December 1980 and was completed in April 1981. The study looked at community and pupil population enrollments, programming and staffing, status of school facilities, fiscal status and concluded with recommendations.

In the fall of 1981, James Associates Architects & Engineers, Inc. was commissioned by the Rossville Consolidated School District to design certain renovation and additions to the existing facilities. The final plan provided for renovating the Kindergarten Suite into an Elementary Library, renovation of the Elementary Office Suite, Multi-Purpose Room, Art Suite, Band Room and Jr/Sr High School Office Suite. Additions to the school included a Kindergarten Suite, Gymnasium, Locker Rooms, Weight Room, Storage Room, Band Practice and Storage Rooms, and Circulation/Lobby Space.

Also, included in the project are new School Administration Offices, a renovated Baseball Field and renovated Parking and Driveway Areas.

This beautifully constructed and educationally sound building is testimony to the people involved in its realization. But more importantly, the Rossville School is a tribute to the men and women of this community who desire quality education for their boys and girls.

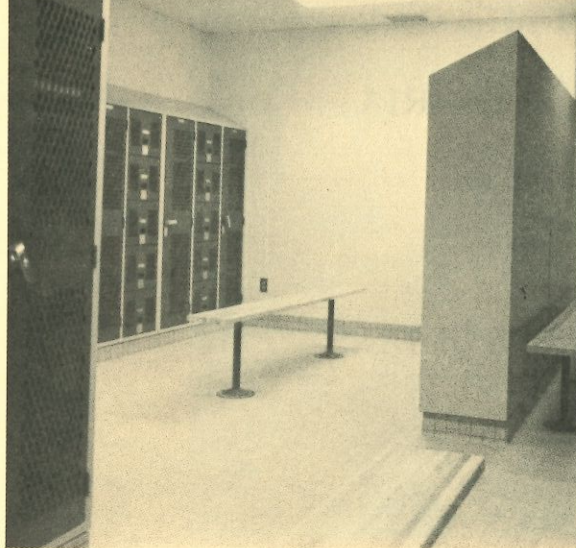

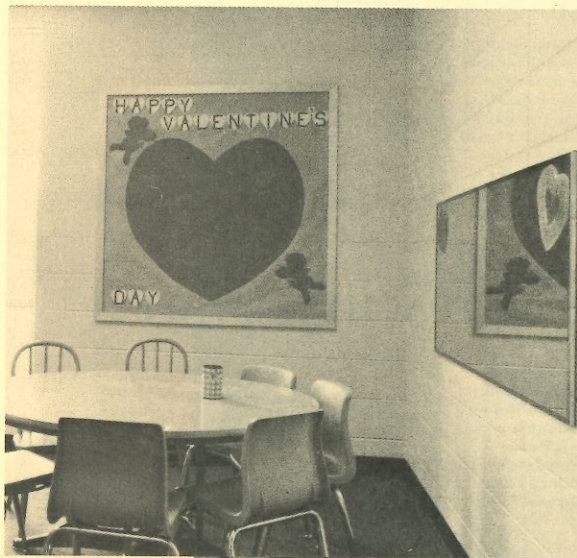

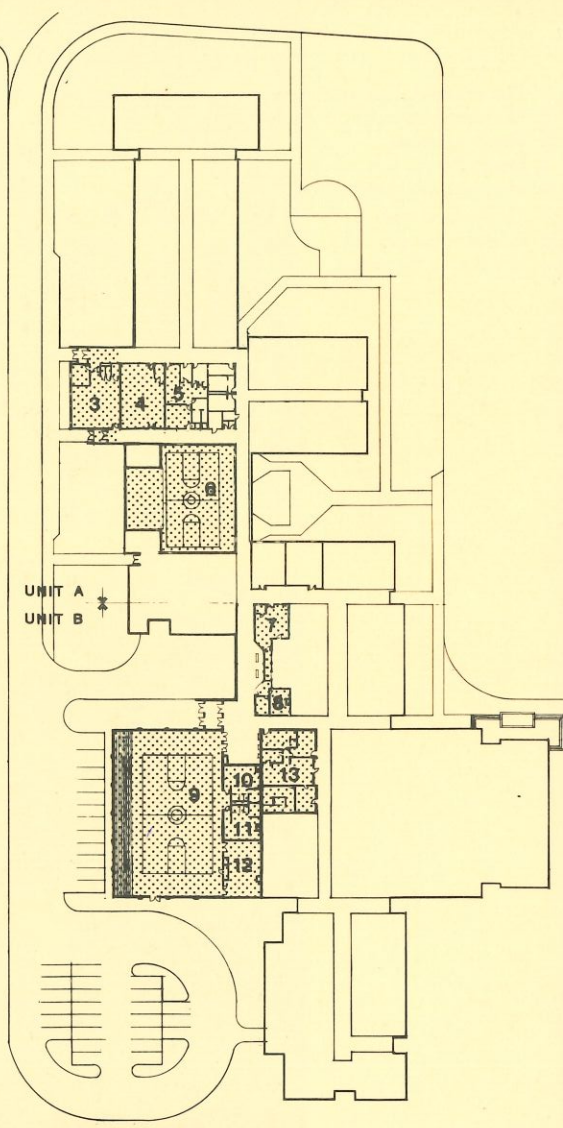

## SPECIAL NOTE

Except for the carpet, heating/cooling, sewage and paving, the class members (under the direction and supervision of Mr. Leon Greives) performed the complete project. The class is to be commended for the quality of their work and for their demonstration of good "work ethics" throughout the duration of the project.





### SPECIFICATIONS:

Foundation - 10-inch concrete block on 10"x24" footing.

Framing - 2"x6" studding braced at outside corners and sheathed with 4"x8"x3/4" styrofoam board; 2"x12" floor joist, 16 inches on center, covered with 3/4 subflooring; roof sheathing is 1/2" plywood, covered with double layers of felt, on which heavy-duty, 240-lb seal-tab shingles are laid.

Walls - 5/8" fire-resistant drywall, with 2x2 suspended ceiling.

Siding - Exterior of the building is red brick.

Insulation - Exterior walls have 6"-thick fiberglass, with vapor barrier; ceilings have 12 inches of fiberglass; foundation has 2" styrofoam.

Floors - Carpet.

Windows - Andersen Perma-Shield.

Overhang - Maintenance-free aluminum.

Doors and Trim - Interior doors are all solid core wood; trim is white pine; exterior door is aluminum with insulated glass.

Cabinets - Homestead Oak, by Merillat, with formica tops and backsplash.

Heating - Heatpump, electric furnace and air conditioner; electric water heater.

Plumbing - Plastic drain and waterlines; water softener.

Electric - 200 AMP entrance box, with circuit breakers.
