

FEDERAL IMPACT FUNDS (INDIAN)

The district gives assurance that tribes and parents will be afforded with the opportunity to make recommendations regarding the needs of their children and will be involved in the planning and development of the basic education program including those educational programs and services to be provided with Public Law 81-874 funds. Indian students will have equal opportunity to participate in the district's program with other students.

The superintendent will establish procedures to assure the involvement of the tribe and parents of Indian students, in the development of the basic education program, including the education services to be provided with Public Law 81-874 funds. The superintendent will provide opportunities for parents and members of the tribal council, to suggest if any policy and / or procedure changes, as well as program changes, are necessary to better serve the needs of the Indian students.
