When and where do Seniors need to be? What should I bring?

Seniors need to be <u>dropped off</u> June 16, 3:45 p.m. at Bothell High School.

- No parking is available for seniors' vehicles at Bothell High School or Pop Keeney.
- Bring your GREEN cap, gown, class stole, and tassel on a hanger to Bothell High School June 16 at 3:45 p.m. marked with your name.
- Gold NHS honor cord and <u>one other WHS pre-approved</u> nationally recognized club cord allowed.

What about my things?

Do NOT bring personal items such as backpacks, purses, make-up bags, phones, cameras, extra clothes, snacks, leis, and/or other non-allowed adornments, etc. to Bothell High School or to the ceremony.
 (Complimentary feminine products will be available for those in need.)

Personal items, valuables, phones, and/or items a senior may want after the ceremony can be kept by parents/guardians and provided to their senior when they reunite upon conclusion of the ceremony.

- No need to bring water or food- a light snack and water will be provided at BHS
- Wear a disposable mask
 - A Falcon mask, to wear at ceremony, will be provided.

Graduation Regalia

Graduation attire:

- A GREEN cap and gown, along with a class stole and tassel.
- Valedictorian stoles will be distributed at Bothell High School.
- Gold NHS honor cord and <u>one other WHS pre-approved cord</u> from a <u>nationally</u> recognized club are allowed.
- Flower leis and/or any other adornments are <u>not allowed</u> during the ceremony.
- Parents/Guardians are welcome to bring other adornments for picture taking when graduates and parents are reunited after the ceremony concludes.
- Tape, signs, flowers, and/or other decorations are NOT permitted on the cap or gown.
- A Falcon mask (will be provided at Bothell High School)

Recommended clothing for Commencement Day

- Recommended clothing includes dress shirts, ties, dresses, skirts, dress pants, and blouses.
- Dresses worn under the gown should not show at the gowns neckline or below the hemline of the gown. To avoid tripping, long dresses should not be worn.
- Seniors should avoid jeans or tennis shoes.
- <u>No heels</u> will be allowed in the stadium on the turf, <u>flats MUST be</u> worn.
- Wear a disposable mask to Bothell High School (a Falcon mask will be provided for the ceremony)

Care of gown:

- If seniors haven't already, place the gown on a hanger and allow it to hang until Commencement day (this permits wrinkles to straighten out and should eliminate the need for pressing).
- The gown (and cap/tassel/stole) must be brought to BHS June 16 at 3:45 p.m. on a hanger marked with the senior's name.
- An inexpensive hanger is recommended. Seniors do not have time to retrieve the hanger or other personal items after the ceremony concludes.
- If necessary, press with a cool to lukewarm iron. Be careful! A hot iron will melt the fabric!
- Seniors keep their gowns, caps, stoles, and tassels after the ceremony, they are not returned to Jostens.

Rehearsal On June 14th: Mandatory

To participate at Commencement on June 16 seniors MUST:

- Attend rehearsal Monday, June 14, 9-11 a.m. at the WHS Softball Field & WHS Football Field
- Alphabetical seat assignments will be provided in advance of rehearsal to facilitate finding your seat at rehearsal
- Seating is designated as being on the "Green" side (home stands) or the "Blue" side (visitor stands) of the stadium to help your parents understand where you will be sitting
 Dress for rehearsal is casual as you will be outside the whole time.

Graduation Ceremony Tickets

Please see the Ticket Process document updated June 1st on the WHS website and emailed out as it has all the details.

- 4 tickets per graduate
- Sections: Vaccinated and Non-vaccinated
- To pick up tickets for the vaccinated section: bring a photo ID/drivers license and the person's vaccination card. Printing the 2 together on paper is acceptable. All members do not need to be present. Please also bring the senior's photo ID if a parent is picking them up.
- If you do not have the correct documentation you will ONLY get non-vaccinated section tickets.

Graduation Ceremony Tickets

Tickets cannot be shared, traded or given to anyone other than the intended recipient. Anyone 16 and older, without a vaccine, must sit in the non-vaccinated section (regardless of a negative test, per guidelines).

The main doors of Pop Keeney will open at approximately 5:15 p.m. Masks are required for those in attendance regardless of vaccination status. <u>Please have your tickets ready as no tickets will be available at the door.</u> Guests with a vaccinated ticket will receive a wristband to be able to sit in the vaccinated section of the stadium. There will be vaccinated and non-vaccinated sections on both sides of the stadium. There will be NO tickets available at Pop Keeney.

→ Please note: ALL fines/fees are required to be paid/cleared prior to receiving the tickets.

Please understand we have a limited capacity in the stadium. Some of our family members will need to watch the ceremony by live stream.
