Rochester Community Schools – Middle School Summer Learning Program

The Rochester Community Schools Summer Learning Program is designed to provide students the opportunity to strengthen their academic skills. There is one 11 day face to face session in the classroom, and three online only sessions, each offering a wide variety of learning experiences.

TUITION – (Non-resident students please refer to the Non-Resident Middle School Packet.)

- **\$150 per Skill Development Course** (\$75 for students who receive Free or Reduced Lunch)
- **\$275 per In-Seat Credit Course** (\$75 for Students who receive Free or Reduced Lunch)
- **\$300 per Online Credit Course** (\$100 for Students who receive Free or Reduced Lunch)

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Online registration will open in May, using the RCS online payment and registration system:

<https://rochesteronline.ce.elevo.com/>. Payments must be made at the time of registration using a debit or credit card. If you do not have access to a computer and/or a debit/credit card, you may register and pay by check, money order (payable to Rochester Community Schools), cash or credit/debit card at the RCS Curriculum Office located on the 3rd floor of the Administration Building at 501 W. University until June 11th. Registration will be available at Van Hoosen Middle School in the Summer School Office starting Monday, June 14th.

REFUNDS

There is a 5% processing fee for refunds before the first day of class. **There are no refunds on or after the first day of class.**

BOOKS

All books must be returned at the end of SLP class. Credit will be withheld until books have been returned.

PE SPORTS ACTIVITIES AND WELLNESS 2

PE Sports Activities and Wellness 2 will meet at Adams High School four days during each session, so students can participate in all sports and activities in the curriculum. GRADES

Grades will be uploaded to Synergy before the start of the 2021/2022 school year. Any student registering for SLP in an attempt to improve a grade from a previous course must enroll in the **exact same course**. The transcript will show that the student has taken the course twice and both grades will remain on the transcript, but only the higher grade will count toward the GPA. Students cannot substitute general courses for honors or AP courses to improve a grade. Honors and AP courses are not offered during SLP. Students can only replace a G or H grade with a G or H.

FINAL GRADES

All classwork must be completed prior to the last day of each session.

NCAA GUIDELINES

It is the sole responsibility of the **student athlete** at all times to make sure that he/she is satisfying the necessary NCAA requirements for Division I or Division II. More information is available at the NCAA website <http://eligibilitycenter.org>.

SAFETY PROTOCOLS

In order to mitigate the risk of spreading COVID-19, processes and mitigation protocols remain in place during SLP, including mask wearing and physical distancing in classrooms and hallways. Students will be subject to the RCS community and state guidelines for contact tracing and quarantine procedures.

ATTENDANCE/CREDIT POLICY

Students taking high school credit courses are **required** to attend the entire eleven (11) day session. Students whose vacation and/or camp schedule interfere with the SLP/SMT should not enroll. A tardy over 5 minutes is considered an absence. **There will be no exceptions to the attendance policy for high school courses. Attendance violation will result in being dropped from the class, no refund and loss of credit for high school courses.**

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Rochester Community Schools Code of Conduct will be followed by SLP/SMT students. **Failure to follow the code of conduct that leads to suspension will result in being dropped from the class, no refund, and loss of credit for high school credit courses.**

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Incoming Ninth Grade Students - Online Learning

Online Learning System is a computer-based learning system that provides students with another medium for achieving academic credit. The Online Learning System allows students to work at their own pace while completing necessary academic courses. Rochester Community Schools does not recommend online courses as preparation for an AP course in the same subject area.

How does Online Learning work?

- Online courses require students to have access to a standalone PC with high speed internet access.
- The teacher will use RCS e-mail to communicate with the students on class days.
- The coursework will be accessible the first day of the session.
- Each online course is designed to be the equivalent of approximately **60 hours of instruction**.
- Students will take notes as part of their online curriculum. Notebooks are considered a vital part of the online learning course. Students are required to take 1 – 1½ pages of notes **per section**.
- **All coursework, notebooks, and assessments must be completed by 9:00 p.m. the night before the last day of the session. There are no exceptions, extensions or incompletes.**
- Students' grades will be based on completing online assessments, their notebooks, and any assigned supplemental materials.

Online Course Tuition (residents only)

**\$300 – Per Online Course. Student must complete course in one session (Available all 3 sessions)
(\$100 per Online Course for students who receive Free or Reduced Lunch)**

There will be a mandatory introductory video for all parents and students to review online course and technology requirements via the SLP website. Questions will be answered via Zoom on the following dates:

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RCS – Geometry for Advancement

This course is designed for students interested in careers requiring a strong mathematical background. Only students who have earned at least a B+ in both semesters of Algebra may enroll. Upon successful completion of both sessions, and at least a 77% on the final exam, students will earn a full credit of Geometry. Therefore, students are required to enroll for both Session 1 and Session 2 and pass the exam with 77% or higher to earn credit. A half credit will not be awarded for partial completion. Daily course work will be expected to be completed at home, requiring access to the internet. Students interested in taking this course must complete the application on the RCS website and turn it in to the counseling department.
