Over the summer months we would like our students to continue to read in order to enhance their reading skills. Summer reading should be both pleasurable and thought-provoking. Through this initiative, students will have an opportunity to meet their individual interests and needs through exposure to quality literature.

For Rising 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Graders

For Rising 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Graders

Students will select a minimum of one book from the K-8 Reading List and read it during the summer. All students entering grades 5-8 will be required to turn in an active reading guide in September for the book they have read.
