



Upper School Remote Learning Policy for 2021-2022

Remote learning (through Zoom) will be offered—at the discretion of the Head of Upper School or the Upper School Academic Dean—due to long-term illnesses or extenuating off-campus activities. Arrangements must be made in advance. Remote learning will not be offered to accommodate last-minute needs or one-time absences (like routine doctor appointments or oversleeping).

Upper School will offer temporary remote learning for students who need to isolate or quarantine after a positive COVID test or after a COVID exposure. This will be offered at the discretion of the school nursing team and the Division Head.

Teachers will partner with students and guide them in completing their work after absences, just as in any school year.
