



Lower School Remote Learning Policy for 2021-2022

Because teachers can be most effective in one learning mode at a time, and because we have found that developmentally, students in Lower School engage best in person, Lower School will not offer a full remote option for students for any reason.

That is, remote learning will not be offered for reasons including, but not limited to, medical appointments, sick days, travel, or other commitments that require missed days of school.

In the event of the need to isolate or quarantine after a positive COVID test or after a COVID exposure, the Lower School will provide asynchronous work for students to complete independently until their return to school. This will be offered at the discretion of the school nursing team and the Division Head.

Teachers will partner with students and guide them in completing their work after absences, just as in any school year.
