PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLAR SEMI-FINALIST

Senior **Anna Rahner** has been named a semifinalist in the 2021 U.S. Presidential Scholars Program, landing her among the top 0.0002% of graduating seniors in the United States.

Inclusion in the U.S. Presidential Scholars Program, now in its 57th year, is one of the highest honors bestowed upon graduating high school seniors. Scholars are selected on the basis of their accomplishments in academics, leadership, and service to school and community. From nearly 3.6 million graduating high school seniors, approximately 6,500 students were identified as candidates for the program and invited to apply. Anna is one of 625 semifinalists.

NATIONAL MERIT

National Merit Corporation sponsors scholarships for collegiate study and screens applicants through their performance on the PSAT in their junior year. Finalists, Semi-finalists and commended students are the highest scoring students in each state and represent less than 1% of each state's graduating seniors.
