This is an honor that is reserved for students who have participated in rigorous programs and academies throughout our district. These requirements were created by Academy teachers, along with Lancaster High School Administration and CTE District Personnel in order to have equity and clear expectations of excellence for all involved.

In order to qualify for the Academy stole at Lancaster High School, all requirements will be met with at least 80% proficiency. All potential Academy graduates will be reviewed by the Academy coordinator by the end of the 3rd quarter for completion of requirements.

Must present and pass the senior defense	(25%)
Cumulative 2.5 or above District Weighted Grade Point Average	(15%)
Must complete a pathway including the capstone course	(15%)
Minimum of a 3.0 Average in CTE classes in grades 11 and 12	(10%)
Minimum of 20 Community Service Hours Complete a reflection on how community service benefited you as a student and our community at large. (This should be included as part of your senior defense.)	(10%)
Take a minimum of one AP course	(10%)
Fulfill A-G Requirements	(15%)

Concrete plans for after high school. Must include one of the following:

- Military Service
- Trade School
- 4-year University Acceptance
- Enrollment in a Community College
- Internship
- Full-Time Employment
