MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES OF THE AVON COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORPORATION

Held on July 9, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees of the Avon Community School Corporation was called to order by the Board President, Mr. John McDavid, at 7:00 p.m. in the Avon Administration Center Board Room.

Four Board members were present: Mrs. Anne Engelhardt, Mr. John McDavid, Mrs. Cindy Simmons, and Mrs. Kim Woodward. Dr. Margaret Hoernemann, Superintendent of Schools; Dr. John Atha, Associate Superintendent; Dr. Maryanne McMahon, Assistant Superintendent; Dr. Scott Wyndham, Director of Finance and Operations; and Ms. Lise Ann Ebert, Director of Human Resources; were also present.

The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the American Flag.

There were 20 persons in attendance.

CELEBRATING ORIOLES

Dr. Hoernemann was pleased to introduce Avon High School seniors Katherine Stegemann and Ella West who were recognized for receiving the Gold Award through the Girl Scouts. This is the highest honor a Girl Scout can receive and is only open to students in high school. To achieve this status they were asked to change the world through a service project.

Inspired by Family Promise of Hendricks County, Katie's 3-tier project included organizing a "Strides for Shelter" 5K run to raise awareness for homelessness, creating blessing bags to distribute to the homeless in downtown Indianapolis, and constructing a teen area at the Family Promise house. 55 participants paid to enter the 5K and donated hygiene items for the blessing bags. Katie was able to combine her love for running and compassion for homelessness to inspire her project.

Ella created "Pretty Pockets" for breast cancer patients recovering from surgery. Ella met with a surgeon to find out how she could make a difference in the lives of women recovering from surgery. Pretty Pockets provide a soft fabric barrier that prevents skin irritation and can be pinned to clothing to prevent tension on the incision. Ella's project was one of ten nominated for the 2018 Girl Scout's National Young Women of Distinction honor. Ella was awarded the Power of Children award by the Children's Museum of Indianapolis.

Mrs. Simmons congratulated Ella and Katie. She knows it's a lot of work but they are doing well.

Mrs. Woodward echoed Mrs. Simmons' congratulations and said this is an honor they will carry with them their entire lives. This is a great resume builder as they are in rarified air. Very many

people do not achieve at that level in scouting. It was magnificent to hear about their work in the community. They have made a difference in the world, right here in Avon.

Mrs. Engelhardt congratulated Ella and Katie on this honor and expressed how great it is to have them in our community. They have truly made a difference in many people's lives. This is a springboard to many things in their future.

Mr. McDavid echoed congratulatory remarks. The work involved and ability to come up with these ideas is remarkable. He thanked Ella and Katie for their contributions to the community and for setting a wonderful example for young girls in our community.

RATIONALE FOR ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

Mr. Shockley, Avon High School Principal, shared the rationale/need to add an assistant principal position at AHS.

Dr. Hoernemann and Mrs. Woodward indicated this position would be paid for with non-taxpayer funds.

APPOINTMENT OF AVON HIGH SCHOOL ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

Mrs. Woodward made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Engelhardt, that the Board of School Trustees approve the appointment of Matthew A. Hines as Avon High School Assistant Principal effective July 1, 2018. The motion carried, 4-0.

CONSENT AGENDA

Mr. McDavid stated the Consent Agenda consolidates a number of business items and all Board members were given documents to review prior to the meeting.

Mrs. Woodward made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Simmons, that the Board of School Trustees approve the Minutes of the Regular Meeting on June 11, 2018, and Working Session on June 18, 2018; claims 100003, 910001037 - 9100001195, 180000398 - 180000437, and 201800615-619 - 201800643-732; payrolls for June 8, and June 22, 2018; the Personnel Report; and registration of support group as presented. The motion carried, 4-0.

COMMENTS FROM THE BOARD PRESIDENT

Mr. McDavid said it was nice to read the Personnel Report and see all of the new hires and to know there are more on the way. School starts before we know it. Everything has gone by fast this summer and there has been a lot to do with our administration. We are happy to be busy.

PUBLIC COMMENT TO THE BOARD

Ms. Tina Northern had a question regarding where to get further information about the Rainy Day Fund.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Dr. Atha reported on student enrollment for the district. Enrollment is at 9,364. Last year at this time enrollment was at 9,310, and we grew 200 students from July to August 2017. We will continue to watch enrollment numbers and class size numbers as students enroll.

Mrs. Engelhardt made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Woodward, that the Board of School Trustees approve new/revised Board Policy 5350 upon second reading as presented. The motion carried, 4-0.

NEW BUSINESS

Mrs. Woodward made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Simmons, that the Board of School Trustees approve revised Board Policy 6610 upon first reading as presented. The motion carried, 4-0.

The regular meeting was recessed.

The Board President opened the Additional Appropriation hearing at 8:01 p.m. Dr. Wyndham presented information relative to the hearing. There were no questions or comments from the public. There were 5 people in attendance. The hearing was closed at 8:07 p.m.

A motion was made by Mrs. Simmons, seconded by Mrs. Engelhardt, that the Board of School Trustees adopt the Additional Appropriation Resolution for the Rainy Day Fund as presented. The motion carried, 4-0.

The regular meeting reconvened at 8:07 p.m.

Dr. Wyndham provided an update on the Wellness Committee Report for the 2017-2018 school year.

Dr. Wyndham and Mr. Brames provided an update on School Resource Officer compensation for the 2018-19 school year.

Dr. Wyndham provided an update on the proposed Fairwood development.

Dr. Wydham provided an update on the citizen request to construct a sidewalk on ACSC Property in Prestwick.

BOARD MEMBER ITEMS

Mrs. Simmons congratulated Ella and Katie. They will be able to use their knowledge of being a Girl Scout in their senior year, college, and later in life. This is a great accomplishment for both of them. She thanked Mr. Shockley for sharing the need for another assistant principal at AHS. Good luck to Mr. Hines. She is happy to see that grades 5-12 are included in suicide prevention, and wished teachers luck on training. She hopes that parents can be involved. She is glad to see

that there are changes in how grants are used. She stated that with the Rainy Day Fund we were able to hire lots of needed educators. She thanked Dr. Wyndham for the updated referendum funding timeline. It makes the Board aware of the additional appropriations that are needed. School Resource Officers are needed more than ever. The Fairwood development is complicated but she is thankful to Dr. Wyndham for attending meetings. She is glad to hear we are doing something with the Prestwick property. Can't believe Avon will celebrate back to school on July 30. As a teacher she was always nervous and excited for a new classroom of students as the students become a big part of a teacher's life. Go Orioles—another great year to begin in all the Avon Schools.

Mrs. Woodward celebrated our Orioles and expressed how gratifying to have this celebration at every meeting. She congratulated and welcomed Mr. Hines. It's great to see our Personnel Report taking shape and feeling like we are getting to classroom sizes that matter for kids. This week we lost Ben Harmon, a great example of what Avon is about. She knew him not only as an Avon student but also as a CRG employee. She wanted to acknowledge his family and that he contributed to this community so greatly. She welcomed the 2018-19 school year.

Mrs. Engelhardt congratulated the two Gold Award recipients. Their projects were fascinating and so beneficial to our community. These are two young ladies who will be fun to watch as they go on in life. She welcomed to Mr. Hines excited to have him here. He has a plethora of experience. She appreciates AHS staff who are taking a look at the schedule to see if we are meeting students' needs. This change is a great way for students to have more solid, consistent relationships with counselors and administrators. She is looking forward to the Back to School Celebration.
