

Oh, how we have missed you! And how excited we are to welcome you back to the Day Camp at Rectory this summer from June 21- August 6, 2021!

WE ARE HOSTING CAMPERS AGES 3 to 12 years old!

We will accept applications all summer until sessions are filled! It's not too late to register!

As we look forward to reopening the Day Camp, I want to inform you of certain COVID protocols that will be in place this year. The goal in implementing these procedures is to assure the safety and most enjoyable summer experience for your child.

- Our camp day will run from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (extended hours 8:00 a.m. & 5:00 p.m. available--fees apply).
- We will continue to offer horse barn activities off-campus 2-3 times/week.
- We will continue to offer golf course driving range/putting green 2-3 times/week.
- **Lunch MUST be brought each day.** Refrigeration will be provided.
- Campers must wear masks in Arts & Crafts while campers are seated at a table with three-foot social distancing when necessary.
- Red Cross swim lessons will be provided.
- Free swim will be allowed in controlled numbers.
- We are working on local trips for the 11/12-year-old group, numbers will be curtailed to 7 per week, as they will be driving off-campus in a minibus. Hiking, biking, and outdoor activities will be stressed, and the beach may be an option later in the summer.
- **Groups will be COHORTED properly to ensure safety.**
- Groups will be held to a maximum of 10-15
- Should we have a camper test positive for the virus, we will close down that age group for 7 days to quarantine. No refunds will be given. Please contact Dena for more information.
 - *Campers will be required to wear masks while indoors, three feet apart (which will be very little time when weather permits)
 - Most activities will take place outdoors when possible to minimize exposure & maximize fun!
 - Only one age group in the locker rooms at one time.
 - Surfaces will be wiped down each time campers are indoors.
 - Each age group will utilize a space 45 minutes at a time & wipe down accordingly.
 - We will continue to operate on a rotating schedule to ensure age-group cohorts moving smoothly from space to space.
 - ALL activities will be outdoor, except possibly for Arts & Crafts.
 - We will wipe down all areas in the art barn before and after Arts & Crafts.
 - Our drama/dance activity will use the amphitheater in the Seaward Student Pavilion.
- We will host 2 "Family Evening" programs, the first in the 3rd week & the second in the 7th week. (To be held outside or virtually.)
- We will continue with our "character counts" beads: responsibility, compassion, respect, honesty, courage, and teamwork at the end of each week.
- All campers are to bring a towel, two bathing suits, a change of clothing, undergarments, hand sanitizer, refillable water bottle, lunch, and additional snack if necessary
