Transferring to a New School at the End of the Year?

Please contact Alice Linterman, registrar, in room 102 or by phone at 360-988-2641, Ext. 3102 or by email [at alice.linterman@nv.k12.wa.us](mailto:alice.linterman@nv.k12.wa.us) to withdraw properly if students will not be returning to NVHS (graduating seniors excluded!) and will be transferring to a new school at the end of the school year. Enrollment at the new school may be delayed if students do not have proper withdrawal documentation. Books/Chromebooks will need to be returned and any fines paid in order for official transcripts to be released to the new school. Please note that the end of semester two is June 17 and teachers will be posting grades at that time in order for credit to be posted onto transcripts.
