HOLLISTON

Use of any tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes, electronic cigars, electronic pipes or other similar products that rely on vaporization or aerosolization, within the school buildings, school facilities, or on school grounds, school buses, or school sponsored trips by any individual, including school personnel and students, is prohibited at all times. Additionally, possession of tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes, electronic cigars, electronic pipes or other similar products that rely on vaporization or aerosolization, by students is prohibited within the school buildings, school facilities, or on school grounds, school buses, or school sponsored trips.

A staff member determined to be in violation of this policy shall be subject to disciplinary action.

A student determined to be in violation of this policy shall be subject to disciplinary action pursuant to the student discipline code.

This policy shall be promulgated to all staff and students in appropriate handbook(s) and publications.

Signs shall be posted on all school properties informing the general public of the district policy and requirements of state law.
