	SCHOOL COMMITTEE ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING	BDA

HOLLISTON

For the purpose of organizing, the Holliston School Committee, at its first regularly scheduled meeting following high school graduation in June, will elect from its membership a chairperson and a vice-chairperson. The Committee will appoint a secretary. All positions will hold their respective offices for a term of one year or until a successor is elected.

The election will proceed as follows:

1. The meeting will be called to order by the Superintendent or, in his/her absence by the Assistant Superintendent.
- 2) Nominations for the office of the chairperson will be made from the Committee membership. The chairperson will be elected by a majority vote of the members present and voting. If no nominee receives a majority vote, the election will be declared null and void and nominations will be reopened.
- 3) Upon election, the new chairperson will preside, calling for the election of a vice-chairperson and secretary, in order. The procedure used for the election will be the same as that for electing chairperson.

Any vacancy among the officers occurring between organizational meetings will be filled by a member elected by the School Committee to serve as interim until the annual organizational meeting. The election will be conducted as described above.

Following election of officers at its organizational meeting, the School Committee may proceed into such regular or special business as scheduled on the agenda.
