The following information was presented and/or action taken on items submitted by Mr. Wesley during the President's Report.

President's Report

Upon motion by Mr. Wesley, seconded by Mr. Stein and carried unanimously by voice vote, the Board approved a temporary suspension of Board Policy No. 006.1, Local Board Procedures/Remote Participation in Meetings to comply with the Governor's mandated school closure and social distancing procedures, effective April 6, 2020. The temporary suspension of Board Policy No. 006.1 shall remain in effect while the District schools are closed to traditional educational programs within the school buildings by mandate of the Governor or otherwise to mitigate the potential for local spread of the coronavirus. During the period in which the Policy is temporarily suspended, there is no limit on the number of occasions in which a Board member may remotely participate in any Board Meeting and there is no requirement that that a majority of Board members, or a Board Member, must be physically present at a Board Meeting when any member or members remotely participate in the meeting. Each member remotely participating in the meeting shall be counted as present for the meeting.
