Student Affairs

Upon motion by Mrs. Hennessey, seconded by Mr. Shages and carried unanimously by voice vote, the Board approved the District entering into a Facility Use Agreement with the YMCA of Greater Pittsburgh/Baierl Family YMCA in order for the YMCA to operate a Before and After School Program at the Hampton Middle School for Hampton Township School District elementary students, subject to approval off the final document by the Board President, Superintendent, and District Solicitor.


Facility Use Agreement with YMCA and HTSD for Before/After School Care Program
